PERSONALITY AND TEMPRAMENT

Like most terriers, Bull Terriers can be very aggressive towards other dogs if left unneutered. To prevent this, they need to have well supervised training and socialisation from an early age. They enjoy daily exercise else they may get up to mischief around the house with all their built-up energy.

COMMON HEALTH PROBLEMS

A severe form of kidney disease is found in Bull Terriers, usually found from an early age. This can be due to undeveloped kidneys. They also suffer with heart defects such as a heart murmur, a cardiac ultrasound may be necessary to diagnose the problem. White Bull Terriers may be prone to skin irritations as their skin is more sensitive which can result in rashes and sores.
